Graeme Power hit a screamer against the crossbar before Chris Reski hit an unstoppable 35 yarder into Evans' top right hand corner on 62. The 4th goal came five minutes later when the excellent Jake Ash set up Tolley for his second of the day.

Substitute Andy Watkins grabbed two tap ins as Westbury tired late on before Darren Garner slotted in the 7th right at the end.
